**Winnie the Pooh:** Grades K-2 (Mondays and Wednesdays 4:30-5:30 pm)

An audition workshop will be held during the first two classes to assign roles and lines. **Willy Wonka:** Grades 3-5 (Tuesdays and Thursdays 4:30-6:00 pm)

Cost: \$450 / Member Cost: \$400

An audition workshop will be held during the first two classes to assign roles and lines. Teachers will assign roles based on students' ability to take direction, work with other students, and speak in a loud, clear voice.

**Wizard of Oz.:** Grades 6-8 (Tuesdays and Thursdays from 6:00-7:30 pm)

Cost: \$450 / Member Cost: \$400

An audition workshop will be held during the first two classes to assign roles and lines. **Cinderella:** Grades 9-12 (Mondays and Wednesdays from 6:00 to 8:00 pm)

Cost: \$450 / Member Cost: \$400

An audition workshop will be held during the first two classes to assign roles and lines. Teachers will assign roles based on students' ability to take direction, work with other students, and speak in a loud, clear voice.
